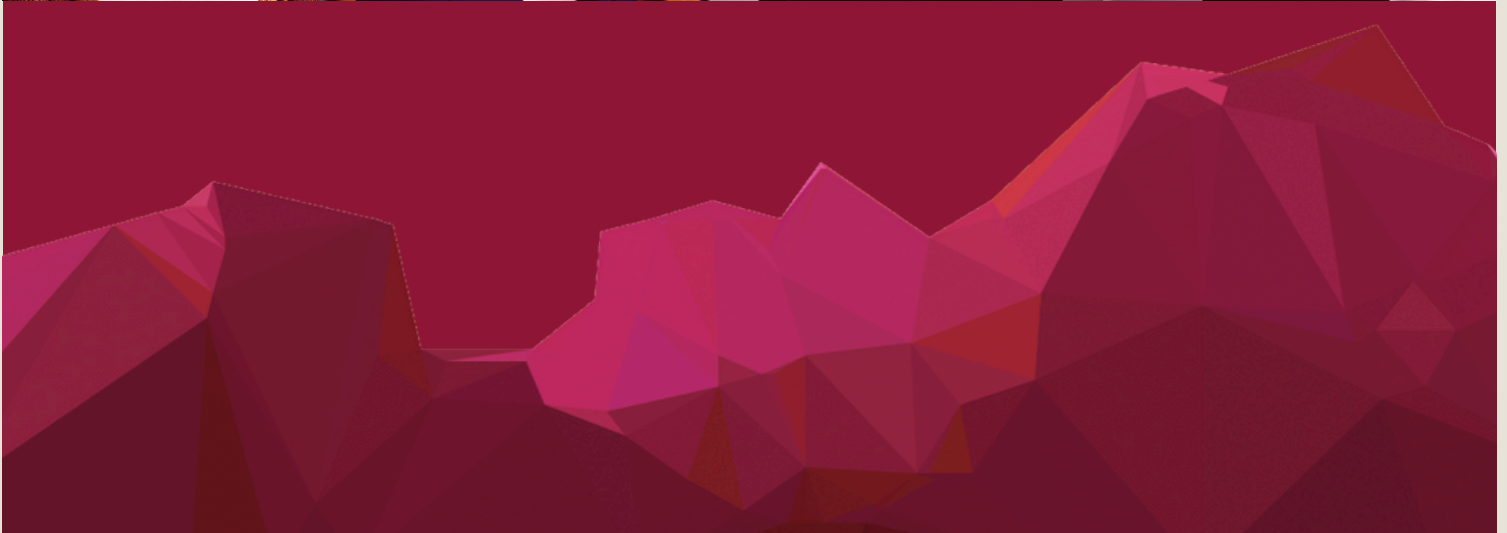


## Long Bio – ~150 words

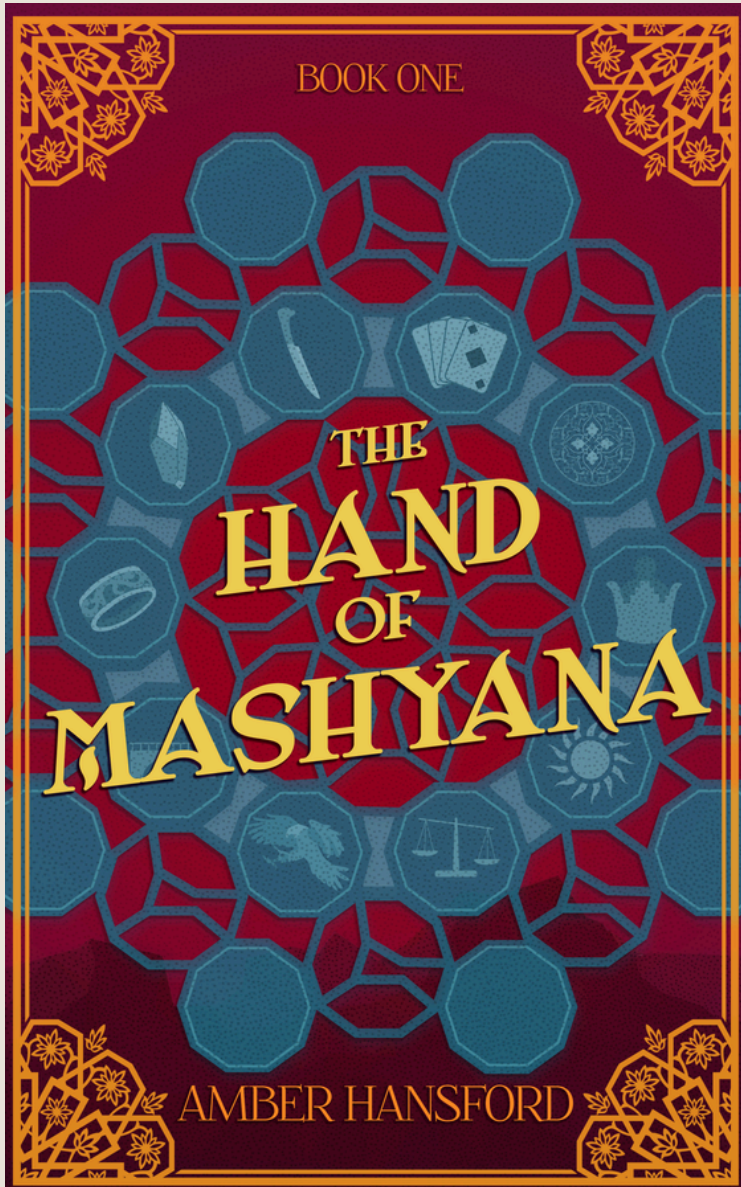
